



## JOB DESCRIPTION: LIFEGUARD

### Objective:

To supervise and teach campers how to have a safe and enjoyable experience around water as a Professional Lifeguard and implementing the American Red Cross Learn to Swim Program.

### Essential Duties

- Ensures the health and safety of the swimmers at all times.
- Plans, directs, and supervises the camp's swim program.
- Actively participates in the camp program and serves as an excellent role model for appropriate behavior at all times.
- Helps provide an atmosphere for developing good morale and well being among the camp family.
- Attends and participates in orientation and weekly staff meetings as requested.
- Implements the American Red Cross Learn to Swim Program for campers.
- Supports the set up of the pool area.
- Provides support to all camp special events.
- Provides supervision and guidance to the Leader-In-Training assigned to your activity.
- Formally participates in a mid-season and end of season staff evaluation with the Aquatics Supervisor.
- Assists in evaluating the pool operation with suggestions for the following season.
- Assists in packing materials and supplies at the end of the season.
- Assists in the inventory of all equipment and supplies.
- Assists in maintaining swim records for campers.
- Conducts daily check of pool area and equipment for safety, cleanliness, and good repair.
- Models nondiscriminatory practices in all activities.

### Job Specifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable individuals with disabilities, who are otherwise qualified, to perform the essential functions.

### Desired Qualifications:

- Desire and ability to work with children and adults in a camp setting.
- Strong ability to communicate well with staff and campers.
- Current Lifeguard Certification.
- Current A.R.C. CPR for the Professional Rescuer Certification or equivalent.
- Current A.R.C. Water Safety Instructor Certification or equivalent.
- At least 16 years of age.

### Working Conditions & Physical Requirements

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform essential functions. Must have the ability to sit and stand for extended periods of time; exhibit manual dexterity to dial a telephone, to enter data into a computer, and to perform; see and read a computer screen and printed material with or without vision aids; hear and understand speech at normal classroom levels, outdoors and on the telephone; speak in audible tones so that others may understand clearly in normal camp settings, outdoors and on the telephone; physical agility to lift up to 25 pounds; and to bend, to stoop, to sit on the floor, to climb stairs, to walk and to reach overhead.

### Work Environment

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Duties are normally performed in an outdoor environment. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
